

## Impact of Pupil Premium Spend 2012-2013

### KS1

#### Attainment

FSM pupils at Rosehill Methodist School were broadly in line with their national peer group in all three subjects and did better in reading and maths however we continue to work hard to close the gap between the results of FSM pupils at Rosehill and those of Non Free School Meal Pupils nationally.

### KS2

#### Attainment

In reading, writing and maths combined FSM pupils at Rosehill attained better than NFSM pupils at Rosehill (27.5 compared to 26.7) and better than FSM pupils nationally (27.2). We continue to work towards closing the gap between Rosehill FSM pupils and Non FSM pupils nationally.

#### Progress

In writing the percentage of FSM pupils at Rosehill who made expected progress from KS1 to KS2 was **higher** than the percentage of non Pupil Premium pupils within school **and higher** than the percentage of non Pupil Premium pupils nationally.

In Maths the percentage of FSM pupils at Rosehill who made expected progress from KS1 to KS2 in Writing was **higher** than the percentage of non Pupil Premium pupils within school and **the same as** the percentage of non Pupil Premium pupils nationally.

In reading the percentage of PP pupils making expected progress was **the same as** the percentage of non PP pupils in school but slightly below the percentage of non PP pupils nationally.
