

Brief Summary of Rewards and Sanctions.

- Positive behaviour is rewarded and follows the structure below:

Positive behaviour → stickers → well done voucher → gold card → entered into gold book

- Reception/Year 1 have their own class rules, sanctions and rewards.
- When a child breaks one of the schools five basic Golden rules, a sanction is given.

1. The 'Look'
2. Reminder of inappropriate behaviour
3. Verbal warning
4. Written warning which then results in loss of golden time:
5mins/10mins/15mins...30mins.
5. A purple slip will be issued for more serious inappropriate behaviour.

- During Lunchtime, **Yellow** cards are issued for positive behaviour and will be rewarded with a sticker; **red** cards issued for inappropriate behaviour which is equivalent to a written warning from the teacher and carry the same sanction.
- **Golden Time** is given to the children once a week on a Friday. During this time, teachers and staff will lead activities with the children which could take many forms; cookery, craft, music, drama or dance, this would be the choice of the staff and children.
At the start of the week, each child is given the whole 30 minutes. However, they will lose five minutes of golden time for each written warning that they receive in one day. The child will then have to either observe the activities for as long as s/he has earned 'time out', or be sent to a 'time out' session for the duration of their time out.
- The school will also reward children who have shown consistently good behaviour, (no written warnings in a $\frac{1}{2}$ term) by organising 'Well Done Activities'. These may be chosen by the children.

The above rewards and sanction are all related to improve behaviour **throughout** the whole school.
