

Sports Premium 2014-2015

In the academic year 2014-2015 Rosehill Methodist Community School will receive a total of £9685 from the DFE for school sports and physical activity. £5650 is allocated to school in October 2014 with a further £4035 in April 2015.

This money has been allocated to address various aspects of our children's physical health and wellbeing.

This includes

- An additional days sports coach to enable all classes from year 1 to year 6 to have access to professional coaching and 4 days of afterschool sports activities for KS 1 and KS2 children. Including multi skill, football and netball, table tennis and basketball
- Due to the success of the multi activity sessions last year it will be continued for this years, year 3 children
- Professional development and training to support a HLTA to deliver early years PE sessions. Also Professional development training for a teacher who has taken on the role as PE coordinator
- Multi activity sessions for year 3 to include climbing, cycling and trampolining.
