

Sports Premium 2015-2016

In the academic year 2015-2016 Rosehill Methodist Community School will receive a total of £9781 from the DFE for school sports and physical activity.

This money has been allocated to address various aspects of our children's physical health and wellbeing.

This includes

- To employ a specialist PE teacher/coach for 4 full days. This includes lunchtime clubs and afterschool clubs that are changed on a half termly basis. These activities caters for KS 1 and KS2 children, and Includes multi skills, Gymnastics, athletics, dance, volley ball, football and basketball
- Transport to and from sporting events. These events will include Football, Off the Blocks, Swimming, Tag Rugby, Basket Ball
- Professional development, training and cover for the PE coordinator
- Buying in the time of an Olympic Gymnast for the afternoon to do workshops and gymnastic display
- New PE equipment including gymnastic mats, soft balls and an athletics equipment bag containing all equipment required for Off the Blocks
