

## **Sports Premium 2016-2017**

In the academic year 2016-2017 Rosehill Methodist Community School will receive a total of £9685 from the DFE for school sports and physical activity.

This money has been allocated to address various aspects of our children's physical health and wellbeing.

This includes

- An additional day sports coach taking it to 5 full days. This will enable all classes from reception to year 6 to have access to professional coaching and 5 days of afterschool sports activities for KS 1 and KS2 children. These clubs including multi skills, football, tag rugby, basketball, dance and gymnastics.
- The dance sessions are particularly well attended so an additional ks1 dance club will take place.
- Professional development training for a teacher who has taken on the role as PE coordinator
- Multi activity sessions for year 3 to include climbing, cycling and trampolining.
- Transport to and from sporting events. These events will include Football, Off the Blocks, Swimming, Tag Rugby, Basket Ball and Volley Ball
